

Clear Lake Community Garden Rules and Regulations

Garden will be tilled and ready for planting by April 16th.

1. Plots are free of charge. Please take care of the land made available for gardening.
2. Assignment of plots will be done on a first come, first served basis.
3. Each gardener is responsible for the maintenance and upkeep of their garden plot. Watering, weeding, harvesting, and any other garden related maintenance are the responsibility of the gardener. Gardeners may arrange for other gardeners to water their plots.
4. Children are welcome in the garden, but must be accompanied by an adult and supervised at all times.
5. No pets are allowed in the gardens.
6. A limited number of tools may be available in a community garden storage bin for use. Gardeners are expected to return tools to the bin when finished gardening for the day.
7. Garden plots should be cared for at least once a week. Any plot that remains unattended for more than 3 weeks is subject to reassignment.
8. There will be an organic section and a non-organic section. Fertilizers, insecticides, weed killers, etc. may be used only in the non-organic section and should be used in a way that it does not affect the organic section.
9. Water will be available in rain barrels. Please only use the water in the barrels and not the spigot of the church. Since the water supply is limited, use sparingly and please make sure you shut off the water spigot from the barrels before watering your plot.
10. Individual fencing of plots is allowed. Please keep structures under 4 feet and looking neat. All fencing must be removed before the Oct. 20th plow date.
11. You may only harvest vegetables and flowers from your own garden.
12. Please do not leave unused or rotten produce in the garden.
13. Gardeners are responsible for clearing out their plot(s) of all materials before the Oct. 20th plow date. All crops not removed by Oct. 20th will be destroyed.
14. Planting of illegal plants is prohibited.
15. Smoking, drinking of alcoholic beverages, and use of illegal drugs are prohibited in the garden.
16. Parking is available in the church parking lot. Please do not park in the grass by the garden.
